Aceclofenac

Composition:

Aclopain ™ Tablet: Each film coated tablet contains Aceclofenac BP 100 mg.

Pharmacology:

Aclopain is a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAIDs). It works by blocking the action of cyclo-oxygenase, which is involved in the production of prostaglandins. Prostaglandins are produced in response to injury or certain diseases and would cause pain, swelling and inflammation. Aclopain also stimulates cartilage matrix (glycosaminoglycans) synthesis.

Indications:

Aclopain... is indicated for the relief of pain & inflammation in osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, ankylosing spondylitis, dental pain, dysmenorrhoea, acute lumbago, knee pain, low back pain.

Dosage & Administration:

Adults: 1 tablet (100 mg) twice daily. 1 tablet in morning & 1 tablet in the evening. Reduce the dosage to 100 mg once daily initially in patient with hepatic dysfunction.

Elderly: The pharmacokinetics of Aceclofenac is not altered in elderly patients, therefore it is not considered necessary to modify the dose or dose frequency.

Children: Not recommended.

Side Effects:

Gastrointestinal discomfort, nausea, diarrhea, ulceration, hypersensitivity reactions, rashes, headache, dizziness, nervousness, depression, drowsiness, insomnia, vertigo etc. may occur.

Precautions:

Aceclofenac should be administered with caution to patients with symptoms indicative of gastrointestinal disorders, with a history of peptic ulceration, ulcerative colitis, crohn's disease, hepatic porphyria & coagulation disorders. Patients suffering from severe hepatic & renal impairment must be monitored.

Pregnancy: This drug should not be used in pregnancy. However, it should be used in pregnancy only if it is clearly needed.

Lactation: This drug should be avoided during lactation period.

Contra-indications:

Aceclofenac is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to Aceclofenac or aspirin or NSAIDs. It should not be administered to patients with active or suspected peptic ulcer or gastrointestinal bleeding & moderate to severe renal impairment.

Storage Condition:

Keep out of the reach of children. Store in a cool and dry place below 30° C, protect from light.

Aclopain $_{\text{\tiny TM}}$ 100 mg Tablet: Each box contains 100 tablets in blister packs.
