Composition:

Roxibac Tablet: Each film coated tablet contains Cefuroxime Axetil USP equivalent to Cefuroxime 250 mg. Roxibac Tablet: Each film coated tablet contains Cefuroxime Axetil USP equivalent to Cefuroxime 500 mg.

Description:

Roxibac To (Cefuroxime) is a well-characterized and effective antibacterial agent, which has broad-spectrum bactericidal activity against a wide range of common pathogens, including ß-lactamase producing strains. Cefuroxime has good stability to bacterial ß-lactamase and consequently is active against many ampicillin-resistant and amoxicillin-resistant strains

Indications:

Roxibac ™ is indicated for the treatment of:

- Upper respiratory tract infections: Otitis media, sinusitis, tonsillitis and pharyngitis.
- Lower respiratory tract infections: Acute bronchitis, acute exacerbations of chronic bronchitis and pneumonia.
- Skin and soft tissue infections: Furunculosis, pyoderma and impetigo.
- Genito-urinary tract infections: Pyelonephritis, urethritis and cystitis.
- Gonorrhea: Acute uncomplicated gonococcal urethritis and cervicitis.
- Early Lyme disease & subsequent prevention of late Lyme disease.

Warning & precaution:

As with other antibiotics, prolonged use of Cefuroxime may result in the over growth of non-susceptible organisms (e.g. Candida, Enterococi & Clostridium difficile), which may require interruption of treatment.

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Pregnancy: All antibiotics should be avoided in the first trimester if possible. However, Cefuroxime has been safely used in later pregnancy to treat urinary and other infections.

Lactation: Cefuroxime is excreted in human milk and consequently caution should be exercised when Cefuroxime is administered to a nursing mother.

Side effects:

Cefuroxime has been associated with nausea and vomiting in a small number of patients.

Drug interactions:

No potentially hazardous interactions have been reported. In common with other antibiotics Cefuroxime may affect the gut flora, leading to lower oestrogen reabsorption and reduced efficacy of combined oral contraceptives.

Storage:

Keep out of the reach of children. Store in a cool and dry place below 30°C, protect from light.
